

Clyde Audrell Hawkins

Clyde Audrell Hawkins was born on 15 July 1900 in Belleville, Yell, Arkansas. He is the son of Claude Rauston Hawkins and Emma Etta Carlson.

On 18 April 1910 Clyde was living with his family in Gravely Township, Yell, Arkansas as recorded on page 172 of film 1374081.

Clyde A. Hawkins enlisted in the United States Army on 3 May 1917 at Little Rock, Arkansas.

He became a corporal in July 1918 and a sergeant on 23 September 1918.

1 February 1919 Clyde A. Hawkins was honorably discharged from the United States Army. He served in the Company B, 86th Infantry, His discharge states he was in the 13th Co. 4th Reg. Bn. 162 Depot Brigade.

Clyde married Effie Williams on 5 May 1919 in Conway, Arkansas.

4 February 1920 census Howard Township, Conway, Arkansas. Clyde is listed with his parents and is listed as single. Page 213 of film 1820057. Claud 37, Emma 39, Clyde 19, Niva 15, Irene 13, Gloyd 11, Cleo 9, Deauvaull 7, and Bernard 2.

Raymond was born on 17 February 1920 in Springfield, Conway, Arkansas.

Effie Williams

Effie Williams was born on 2 July 1901 in Mt. View, Stone Arkansas. She is the daughter of George Lee Williams and Sarah Catherine McGee.

The Williams family was living in Blue Mountain Township, Stone, Arkansas at the time of the census on 11 May 1910 as recorded on page 44 of film 1374077.

Effie has not been found on the 1920 census. She was about to deliver her first child and may be staying with someone else and was not recorded on the census.

Effie died on 30 December 1981 in Federal Way, King, Washington.

Ilene was born 25 August 1922 in Plummerville, Conway, Arkansas.

Ormond was born 14 January 1925 in Springfield, Conway, Arkansas.

The family moved to Oklahoma in 1926.

The Hawkins family was living in Seminole City, Seminole, Oklahoma on 15 April 1930 for the census. Clyde is 29 and works in a plumbing shop, Effie is 28, Raymond 10, Ilene 7, and Ormond 5. Found on sheet 18B of the census.

In 1937 the family moved to Vallejo, Solano, California.

Clyde was a welder in the naval shipyards in Vallejo, California.

In 1977 their health was failing and they moved to Renton, Washington to live in a downstairs apartment in their daughter Ilene Gebinini's home.

Clyde died on 8 December 1984 in Des Moines, King, Washington.
