

George Lee Williams

George Lee Williams was born on 28 June 1867 in Ripley, Missouri. He was the son of James M. Williams and Martha Ann Killingsworth.

George's parents apparently both died soon after George's birth as they are not found in the 1870 or 1880 census records. George Williams, age 4, is living in Washington, Ripley, Missouri on 6 August 1870. He is living with Henry Woolard, 26 and Mary Branch, 30. In 1880 George's sister Annie is listed in Fulton County, Arkansas

The only person that I can find in the 1880 census that closely matches George's information is a George W. Williams, age 11, living in Union, Lincoln, Missouri. He is living with Abner B. Barye (Barge), age 35.

George Lee Williams married Sarah Catherine McGee on 25 July 1892 in Stone County, Arkansas as recorded on their marriage license.

William was born on 5 July 1894 in Stone, Arkansas. 1893 as listed in 1900.

Sarah Catherine McGee

Sarah Catherine McGee was born 17 October 1874 in Wayne, Tennessee. She is the daughter of Andrew Jackson McGee and Christina Patterson. 1900 census gives her birth as November 1873.

The McGee family was living in Sylamore Township, Stone, Arkansas on 15 June 1880 as recorded on page 181 of film #1254057.

Dovie was born on 19 January 1898 in Stone, Arkansas.

The George Williams family is living in Sylamore, Stone, Arkansas on 15 June 1900 as recorded on page 21 of film #1240077. George L. is 32, farmer, Kate C. 26, William 6, Noah 4, and Dovie 2.

Effie was born on 2 July 1901 in Mountain View, Stone, Arkansas.

The Williams family is living in Blue Mountain Township, Stone, Arkansas on 11 May 1910 as recorded on page 44 of film # 1374077. George is 41, farmer, Sarah C. is 32, Willie 16, Nora 13, Dovey 11, Effie 8.

Though George was still alive in 1920 he has not been located on the census records.

George died on 17 January 1923 in Welborn, Conway, Arkansas as recorded on his death certificate. He is buried in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery, in Conway, Arkansas. This cemetery is also called Hill Creek Cemetery and is located in Plummerville.

Sarah died on 16 June 1920 in Howard, Conway, Arkansas as recorded on her death certificate. She is buried next to her husband in Hill Creek Cemetery in Plummerville, Conway, Arkansas.
