

## George Bagnell

George Bagnell was born on 10 December 1834 in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England to Thomas Bagnell and Mary Smith Bagnell.

The 1841 census for Drayton in Hales, Drayton Parva, Shropshire, England is recorded on film #474579. Thomas is 40, Ann is 39, Elizabeth 11, Thomas 7, George 6, James 4, and Jane 4 months.

In March 1851 George is found working as a servant to Thomas Goodall in Westanwich, Shropshire, England. He is 16 years old. This census is recorded on LDS film #87398.

George Bagnell is married to Elizabeth Naggington some time around 1859. No marriage record has yet been found.

On 16 March 1860 their first son Thomas is christened in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England.

In April 1861 George Bagnell is living in Drayton Parva, Shropshire, England on Longslow Lane. He is a bricklayer's labourer by trade and is listed as 27 years old. Elizabeth is 26 and Thomas is 1. LDS film # 5428823. His father is listed two houses down on the census, living on Rush Lane. His brother William is two houses above him on the census, living in Town Fields.

On 4 April 1862 a son George is christened in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England.

In 1865 Jesse is born in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England.

In 1866 Henry is born in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England. He is also known as Harry.

On 3 July 1868 another son John is born in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England.

Late in 1870 or early 1871 William is born in Market Drayton, Shropshire, England.

On 10 April 1871 the George Bagnell family is found living on Langslow Lane, Townfields, Drayton Parva, Shropshire, England. George is

36, Elizabeth is 37, Thomas 11, George 9, Jesse 7, Harry 5, John 3 and William 4 months.

George is an Agricultural labourer. This is recorded on page 27 of LDS film# 0838848. His brothers William and Thomas and his father Thomas are all living nearby.

On 16 June 1873 Mary Ellen is born in Claverly, Shropshire, England. It is noted that the 1881 census states her birthplace is Wolverhampton.

At the time of the census in April 1881 the family is living on Bone Mill Lane in St. Marys, Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. George is 46 years old and working as a general labourer. Elizabeth is 47 years old. Thomas is 21 is and engine cleaner, George 19 is an engine fitter, Jesse 16 is and engine painter, Harry 15 is a forge labourer, John is 12, and Mary E. is 7 years old. This information is recorded on pg 32 of LDS film # 1341671.

The family is located at 27 Bone Mill Lane in the 1891 census film, page 35, for Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. George is 56 years old, general labourer, born in Market Drayton. Elizabeth is 57, born at Cheswardine. Son John age 22 at Bran Moulder, born in Market Drayton is living with them. Also a daughter Mary E. age 17 a dress maker, born in Wolverhampton is living with them.

In 1901 the family is still living on Bone Mill Lane, St. Mary, East Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. George is 65 years old as is listed as a Stationary Engine Driver by occupation. Elizabeth is 64 years old. This is on pg 24 of the census record.

The George Bagnall family is living at 46 Bismark Road, Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England at the time of the 1911 census. Living in the house are George, 76, retired formerly general labour, and Elizabeth, 75. They have been married for 52 years and they have 5 out of 7 children still living.

It is not yet known when George Bagnell died.

## Elizabeth Naggington

Elizabeth Naggington was christened on 6 Dec 1835 in Cheswardine, Shropshire, England. Her parents are John Naggington and Eleanor Jones.

The family is living in Stoke Upon Tern, Stoke Heath, Shropshire, England as recorded in the census for 1841, film # 474579. John is 27, Ellen is 30, Elizabeth 5, Ann 3, and John is 6 months old.

In March of 1851 Elizabeth is working as a servant to John Goodall, who is the son or brother of Thomas Goodall for whom George Bagnell was working. This explains how George and Elizabeth come to know each other. Elizabeth was 16 years old at the time of the census living in Westanwich, Shropshire, England, as recorded on film #87398.

Elizabeth has not yet been found on the 1911 census for Staffordshire, England.

Elizabeth has not yet been found on the 1921 census for Staffordshire, England.

Elizabeth died on 4 Dec 1925 in Staffordshire, England.
