

Henry Friday

Henry Friday was born in Maryland sometime about 1812 to 1815. Later references in his life to him as Henry Friday Jr. would indicate his father's name was also Henry.

The 1820 census record for the 1st District of Frederick Co. Maryland as recorded on page 86 of film # 193705 lists the following household members: 2 males less than 10 (Frederick, 9 and Henry, 7), 1 male 26 to 45 (Henry Sr. 24), 1 female less than 10 (unknown), 1 female 26/45 (Mary), with one person being an unnaturalized foreigner.

Henry Friday's family is recorded on the Frederick County, Maryland census on 24 November 1830. They are listed in District 3 on page 47 of film #013180. Living in the household are 1 male 15 to 20 years of age, 1 male 30 to 40 years old, one female 10 to 15, one female 40 to 50 and one female 70 to 80.

On 1 June 1840 at the time of the census the Friday family is living in the Jefferson District of Frederick County, Maryland. They are recorded on page 321 of film #013185. Living in the household are on male 5 to 10, 2 males 20 to 30, one male 50 to 60, one female 20 to 30 and one female 50 to 60.

Archives of Maryland, Volume 592, Page 36, Session Laws, 1840,

William Grason, Esquire, Governor, Chapter 44. Passed Feb. 8, 1841. Deed made valid.

An act to confirm and make valid a Deed of Conveyance from Henry Friday, Senr., to Henry Friday, Jr., and Frederick Friday of Frederick County. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland that the deed of conveyance from Henry Friday, sr. to Henry Friday, jr., and Frederick Friday, bearing date on the eighth day of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, and recorded in the office of the clerk of Frederick county court, and conveying to Henry Friday, jr., and Frederick Friday, certain real estate in Frederick county, particularly described in said deed, for the consideration of two hundred and fifty-three dollars, be and the same is hereby confirmed and made valid, and the title to the real estate therein described, shall be held to be as fully vested in the grantees, therein named, in all respects, as though the grantor at the time of the execution thereof, had been a naturalized citizen of the United States.

On 22 October 1846 Henry Friday married Catharine Ann Delashmutt in Frederick, Maryland. This

marriage is recorded in the Jacob Engelbrecht Marriage Ledger of Frederick County, on page 37, #1574. The marriage took place in the Evangelical Lutheran or Lutheran Congregational of Zion Church in Middletown, Frederick, Maryland.

A son, James B. Friday was born in 1848 in Frederick, Maryland. In 1850 on 16 July James B. Friday, age 2, is living with Ann Delashmutt age 57, who is thought to be his grandmother.

Catharine died on 1 December 1848 in Frederick, Maryland. She was 25 years 11 months and 7 days old.

Henry Friday Jr. married Ann Preston on 8 June 1850 in Frederick, Maryland. Recorded in The Jacob Engelbrecht Marriage Ledger of Frederick Co. Page 38, #1597.

The Friday family was recorded in the census on 16 July 1850 living in Buckeye Township of Frederick, Maryland. Page 224 of film #443522 & 443523. Henry is 35 years old, a plasterer by occupation and Ann C. is 20 years old.

William Henry Friday was born on 11 June 1853 probably in Frederick, Maryland. One source lists his birth place as Virginia.

Mary Lucy Friday is born in 1857 in Maryland. Mary married Ebenezer A. Hight Wooliver on 23 February 1876 in Dent, Missouri. It is not known when she died.

Sophia is born in 1858 in Maryland. Sophia Friday married in Adair co. Missouri on 7 Dec 1875 to Christian Lowenguth (Loevenguth)

The family is living in Frederick Maryland on 21 July 1860 at the time of the census. They are living in Jefferson Township as recorded on page 425 of film #803474. Henry is listed as 46 years old and a laborer., Ann is 30 years old. William is 8, Mary is 6 and Sophia is 2 years old. They live in Burkittsville post office.

Marzilla is born on 4 October 1861 in Maryland. 1880 there is a Tilda Friday, other relationship, living with A. L. & Ellen M. Hickman in Hannibal, Marion, Missouri, on pg 235C. She is listed as 25, born in Maryland. She was living with her nephew and sister-in-law, Willie R. Friday and Mary E. Friday

Edmonds in 1910 in Black River, Butler, Missouri. She was still single.

Charlie D. is born in 1862 in Maryland. Charlie is believed to have been married and lived in Texarkana later in life.

F.M. is born in 1866 in Illinois.

Nancy is born in 1868 in Missouri. In 1880 there is a Nancy Friday living as a ward with the W. J. Gortney family in Salem, Dent County her age is listed as 12. and that her father was born in Prussia.

The family is living in Salembouough Township, Dent, Missouri on 19 July 1870. They are recorded on page 631 of the census film #552273. Henry is

listed as 58 years old and a plasterer by occupation, his son W. H. 17 is listed as an apprentice plasterer. A. E. is 34 years old, M. M. is 13, M. S. is 10, C. L. is 9, E. M. is 4 and N. M. is 2. Note that W. J. Gortney and his wife are living in the house at this time. In 1880 the daughter Nancy is living with them.

John is born in 1870 in Missouri.

The Henry Friday Family is not found in the 1880 census. It is assumed that they have died prior to this time. Three of the children are found living with other families at this time. It is possible that the family were victims of some epidemic illness.

Ann C. Preston

Ann C. Preston was born in Maryland in about 1827. It is not known who her parents are for sure but it is possible she is the daughter of Joshua Preston. Further research may verify this possibility. It is also possible she is the daughter of the woman listed in the 1840 census for Frederick, Maryland as Mrs. Preston.

Mrs. Preston is listed on page 161 of the Frederick, Maryland census film # 013185. Living in the household are 1 female <5, one female 5 to 10, one female 10 to 15, one female 30 to 40, and one female 60 to 70.

Ann C. Preston married Henry Friday on 8 June 1850 in Frederick, Maryland.

The Henry Friday family is listed on page 224 in Buckeye Township on the 16 June 1850 in the Frederick Co. Maryland Census.
