

## James Brown

James Brown was christened on 11 April 1841 in Codsall, Staffordshire, England. His parents were Edward and Hannah Jenks Brown.

The Edward Brown family in June 1841 is living in Codsallwood, Codsall, Staffordshire, England, LDS film # 474627. Living in the household are Edward 40, a farmer, Hannah 35, George 13, Ann 9, John 8, Edwin 6, Thomas 2 and James 1 month. All were born in Staffordshire.

The family is listed in Codsall, Staffordshire, England in the 1851 census. Edward is 50, farm labourer, born in Sedgely. Hannah is 47 born in Pattingham, George 23, John 18, Edwin 17, James 7, Henry 5 and Fanny 4 all born in Codsall complete the household, page 23 of film #87420. LDS film #87422 and 87423.

James Brown is living with his parents in 1861 in Compton, Tettenhall, Staffordshire, England. He is 20 years old and is listed as a hollowware (iron) occupation.

Some time around 1862 James Brown married Emma Price presumably in Staffordshire, England. An actual marriage record has not yet been located.

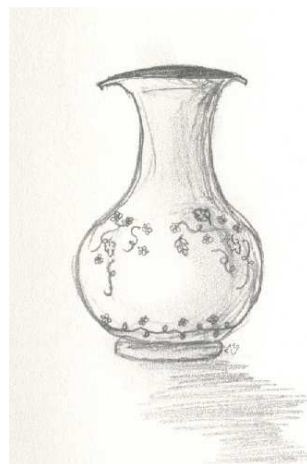
On 25 March 1863 their first child was christened in St. Luke's Parish, Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. She was named Fanny.

In 1865 their first son William was born in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England.

In 1869 a second daughter, Emma E. was born in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England.

In 1871 another daughter, Annie S. or G., was born in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. The handwriting on the census record is unclear as to Annie's middle initial.

The family is located on page 62 of the April 1871 census for Staffordshire, England, LDS film #s 836416 thru 836419. They are living in Wolverhampton, James 29, Emma 30, William 6, Emma E. 2, and Annie L. 2 months. James is a hollowware turner. They lived on Inkorman Street.



James was born on the 4 March 1873 in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. This may be a christening date.

Fredrick was born in 1875 in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England.

Charlotte was born in 1878 in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England.

Christopher was born in 1880 in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England.

The family is found in the 1881 census living on Duke St. in Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. James is 39 years old and is listed as a hollowware turner. It is assumed that he was working in the china pottery industry which Staffordshire is famous for. Emma is listed as being 40 years of age. William 16, Emma E. 12, Annie S. 10, James 8, Frederick 6, Charlotte 3, and Christopher 1 are living at home.

The family has been identified on the 1891 census, page 25, for Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. They are living at 243 Steelhouse Lane, Wolverhampton. In the family are James, age 49, Hollowware Turner, born in Codsall. Emma, age 50, born in Claverly, Shropshire. William, age 26, hollowware turner. James 18, tailor, Fred, 16, hollowware turner, Charlotte 13, Christopher 11, Anny 9, and George 8 are living at home. All children were born in Wolverhampton.

A death date has not been found for James Brown, but it was apparently before 1901.

## **Emma Price**

Emma Price was born in Claverly, Shropshire, England sometime around 1841. Her parents are John Price and Elizabeth. Elizabeth's maiden name has not yet been identified.

The March 1851 census film for Shropshire, England is 87387. Her father is listed as 38 years old and occupied as a cordswainer.

The family is listed in the 1861 census living in Claverly Village, Shropshire, England as recorded on LDS film #542877.

Emma is living in at 30 Manwell Road in 1901. She has remarried and is listed as Emma Payner, age 60. Living with her are Fred 25, a

hollowware turner fitter, Christopher 21, a tailor, George 18, and Anny Huffadine 19, a daughter, Harry Huffadine is listed as a lodger, 20 years old. I suspect this is Anny's husband.

Emma Poyner is living with her daughter and son-in-law at 1 Edward Street, Wolverhampton, Staffordshire, England. Living in the household are Walter Henry Huffadine, 33, Anny Louise Huffadine, 29, and Emma, 70, mother-in-law, born in Claverley, Salop, England.

A death date for Emma Price Brown has not yet been found.
